



ADDITIONALLY, IN APRIL OF 2015, IAVA LAUNCHED A HIGH-VISIBILITY PUBLIC AWARENESS CAMPAIGN "SOMETIMES EVEN HEROES NEED HELP" IN ROCKEFELLER PLAZA, WHICH REACHED APPROXIMATELY 250,000 PEOPLE PER DAY. THESE ASTOUNDING EFFORTS WERE SUPPORTED BY OUR EXTENSIVE SOCIAL MEDIA AUDIENCE; IN 2015, OUR TOTAL SOCIAL MEDIA FOLLOWERS INCREASED BY 3.5% TO 564,920 AND OUR SIGNATURE #VETSRISING HASHTAG CAMPAIGN ALONE REACHED 15.4 MILLION IMPRESSIONS DURING VETERANS WEEK.

IN 2015, IAVA EXPERIENCED THE HISTORIC PASSAGE AND SUBSEQUENT SIGNING OF THE CLAY HUNT SAV ACT, AS WELL AS THE INCLUSION OF A PERMANENT EXTENSION OF THE JAMES ZADROGA HEALTH ACT INTO THE OMNIBUS APPROPRIATION BILL SIGNED BY THE PRESIDENT. DURING THE YEAR, IAVA'S STAFF AND MEMBERS DELIVERED 20 TESTIMONIES (UP 43% FROM THE PREVIOUS YEAR) ON ISSUES AFFECTING OUR COMMUNITY.
